AL-BETA(0102) [Auburn University; advisor, Keren Gorodeisky] The philosophy club is planning an outreach program to teach children in the public schools; the program will begin with Auburn High School and perhaps extend to the elementary schools later. The emphasis will be on teaching critical thinking, and the Auburn students are interested in providing an introduction to philosophy to high school students. A second outreach program is planned for the Gnu's room where two or three professors and two or three students will discuss general topics such as beauty, literature, and education; in the first meeting of this program we will consider how we judge beauty and art. The club expects to play an active role in the second annual meeting of the **Auburn University Philosophy Conference** in March; the topic is "The Metaphysics of Ordinary Objects." Throughout the year, members will be working on papers for submission to journals and graduate schools; the meetings will be devoted to reading and discussing these papers. The film series will continue on Fridays when there are not other meetings.
