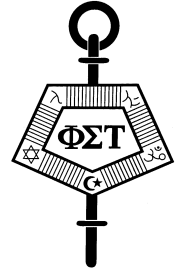

Each year our chapter sponsors a series of events on a special topic; this year the theme is "Methods and Approaches to Philosophy." As we considered a theme for this year, students urged us to provide talks that would help them become acquainted with various approaches to philosophy. So far, we have commitments for talks on the approaches of Naturalism, Existentialism, and Phenomenology, though other approaches will be included later, particularly Analytic Philosophy and Buddhism.

Our first installment of "Philosophers Talk about Philosophy" was a great success. About forty people attended the event on October 25, and Professors Bill Knorpp, Tracy Lupher, and Chip Bolyard spoke. Professor Bolyard spoke mainly about the method and history of philosophy and considered periods of philosophy, intellectual history as opposed to history, and other things. Dr. Knorpp spoke about the types of method in the history of philosophy, methods employed by different philosophers, and how philosophical method is important. Dr. Lupher spoke on the methods of mathematics and science and their relation to philosophy. The event concluded with the floor opened to questions from the audience.

In addition to our series, "Philosophers Talk about Philosophy," we plan to organize an information series on graduate school for Phi Sigma Tau members and other philosophy majors. We will also hold bi-monthly meetings to discuss papers written by Phi Sigma Tau members, to read short articles for group discussions, and to discuss the philosophical implications of current events. Chapter members considered setting up a discussion site for talking about papers. We also talked about designing and ordering a PST sweatshirt.

At our September 27 meeting, we discussed Nietzsche's Eternal Recurrence from *The Gay Science*. Krystel Holst gave a brief background on Nietzsche; key points of the discussion were 1) the world isn't an organism that depends upon us, 2) all actions are equally important, and 3) all change must be predetermined. Some questions arose. Is this a cosmology or some sort of ethical guideline? If Eternal Recurrence is a cosmology for Nietzsche, how can we prove it?
