**AL-ALPHA(0101)** [Spring Hill College; advisor, Gregory J. Morgan] NEW ADVISOR

**AR-ALPHA(0401)** [Lyon College; advisor, Martha C. Beck] The Lyon College chapter works closely with the campus minister to cosponsor presentations that further the common ministry, especially issues of social justice and the relation between reason and faith. Among events sponsored by the Lyon chapter were a bake sale to raise funds for a playground in a neighborhood in Batesville, sponsoring two students to attend a conference "Creating a Culture of Peace and Justice" in Little Rock (Dr. Beck was one of the speakers at the conference), a presentation by Lindsay Hodge on her work at an orphanage for Sudanese children who had crossed into Rwanda, and a presentation by a former Lyon graduate who had been involved in the demonstrations surrounding the "Jena 6" controversy. The Lyon chapter sponsored a number of other events.

**AR-GAMMA(0403)** [University of Central Arkansas; advisor Jacob Held] At the March meeting, our chapter continued its discussion of details of our conference, a conference which went well despite its being our first attempt; we had a great response. Officers will be elected at the next meeting.

**CA-IOTA(0509)** [Westmont College; advisor, Jim Taylor] We were granted club status at Westmont and sponsored several events, among them faculty debates on the possibility of artificial intelligence, movie nights, and in conjunction with the Philosophy Club from Santa Barbara City College a barbeque. We also cosponsored with SBCC a lecture by Dr. Tom Crisp of the Biola philosophy department.

**CA-MU(0512)** [University of California, Santa Barbara; advisor, Burleigh T. Wilkins]. During the spring, the UC Santa Barbara chapter held a discussion of the Chomsky—Foucault debate on human nature and justice versus power. One of our members read a paper on the philosophy of mind that criticized Stich's argument against wide content. A future topic for discussion may be the ontological status of beliefs. We are also planning an information session on applying to graduate programs in philosophy.

**DC-GAMMA(0903)** [American University; advisor, Andrea Tschemplik] The DC-Gamma chapter made a trip to the Library of Congress in April. The Dean has approved our journal, and authors submitted articles in the first week of May. We also participated in a book drive to support "Partner with Justice Not Jails," an organization that distributes books to prison libraries.

**FL-THETA(1008)** [Florida Southern College; advisor, Dan Silber] The chapter at Florida Southern hosted Dr. Gary Hardcastle of Bloomsburg University. Dr. Hardcastle, who is co-editor of *Monty Python and Philosophy* gave two talks: "Dead Parrots and Black Knights: Philosophy by Way of Monty Python" and "Analytic Philosophy as Reflected in Monty Python."

**FL-LAMBDA(1011)** [University of West Florida; advisor, Sally Ferguson] The Florida Lambda chapter participated in the Festival on the Green by having a philosophy reading with members reading

from their favorite philosophy books. At the March 12 meeting, we discussed Bertrand Russell's "Why I am not a Christian."

**GA-BETA(1102)** [Emory University; advisor, Fred Marcus] The Emory chapter's induction dinner also served as the departmental honors dinner. Robert Cummings Neville of Boston University delivered the keynote address: "Time and Eternity: Improving Process Metaphysics." The chapter sponsored monthly meetings with senior faculty members speaking about topics of interest, among them the origin of philosophy, existentialism as a way of life, and philosophical naturalism.

**GA-ETA(1107)** [Georgia Southern University; advisor, William Eaton] The chapter's longtime goal is to create a student philosophy library dedicated to retired professor John Parcels. A location has been secured in the departmental student lounge, books have been donated, and money for a plaque has been raised. Professor Parcels gave a lecture on April 9, and the chapter presented him with the plaque. Much of the term the chapter advertised and promoted Daniel Garber's lecture, "Descartes Against the Materialists." The lecture was well received and provoked a lively question and answer period.

**IL-ZETA(1406)** [University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign; advisor, Robert Wengert] Despite the illness of our Vice-President, our chapter has been active during the past school year. At our last event, we discussed with the departmental chair what the department could do for students majoring and minoring in philosophy. On Saturdays, we worked with a local "Books to Prisoners" program.

**MA-ETA(2207)** [Bridgewater State College; advisor, Aeon Skoble] During our February meeting, we considered several possibilities for events: Walden Pond, the Polar Bear Club, and movie viewing. Informal discussions centered on Existentialism and Post-modernism.

**MA-THETA(2208)** [Merrimack College; advisor, Monica Cowart] Officers were elected at the February meeting. We are planning a banquet for late April and considering several topics for a discussion or a panel. Some possibilities for a discussion are immigration, same-sex marriage, or another ethical issue; a panel might consider perspectives on the war. Future events may include readings, discussions of philosophical topics, or discussion of student papers.

**NY-ETA(3307)** [LeMoyne College; advisor, C. Tabor Fisher] Peter LaVine, one of the members of our chapter, won the departmental Leonard Markert Medal in Philosophy. The award is given to the outstanding graduating senior.

**NY-IOTA(3309)** [Long Island University; advisor, Jill Kreitman]

Our induction ceremony for the 2006-2007 school year honored Dean Emerita, Dr. Maithili Schmidt; Dr. Schmidt had been our advisor. The lecture on ethics delivered at the ceremony was well-attended.

**NY-OMEGA(3324)** [Niagara University; advisor, Alexander U. Bertland] The Niagara University chapter held a number of events in conjunction with the Philosophy Club. The main events were a series of roundtable discussions on topics of student interest; one student would make a short presentation of the arguments on each side and then lead the discussion. Among the topics were the right to privacy, the nature of truth, capital punishment, and abortion. Our chapter also assisted with the Eastern Regional Meeting of the Society of Christian Philosophers with its conference held at Niagara University.

**PA-MU(3912)** [Villanova University; advisor, Paul Livingston] We extended the deadline for conference papers by two weeks and worked to advertise the conference. The "Language and Politics" conference was scheduled for April 19, and work continued on publicizing and promoting the event.

**PA-TAU(3919)** [University of Scranton; advisor, Ann Pang-White] During the 2007-08 school year, the Pennsylvania Tau chapter sponsored several philosophy cafes and published the first issue of *Discourse*, our new journal. Three paper contest winners presented their work at our May Philosophy Forum.

**PA-PSI(3923)** [University of Pennsylvania; advisor, Zoltan Domotor] The Pennsylvania Psi chapter sponsored a number of activities during the year. Among them were a screening of the movie "Wittgenstein," an Ayn Rand reading group, weekly chats at a local pub, lectures by philosophy faculty on their research, a debate between Charles Kahn and Gary Hatfield (Aristotle versus Descartes on Conceptions of the Mental), and a public lecture by Daniel Dennett that was attended by more than 450 people (with PST members invited to dine with Professor Dennett). Many of the graduating seniors received offers to top Ph.D. programs in philosophy, including offers from Stanford, Princeton, and Michigan.

**RI-ALPHA(4001)** [Providence College; advisor, Philip E. Devine] Our chapter held four main events during the last school year. They included lectures by Dr. Anthony Celano ("Aristotle and Thomas on Practical Wisdom"), Dr. Andrew Peach ("Are All Children Adopted?"), Dr. Agnes Curry ("Just a Family Affair: Buffy the Vampire Slayer and the Crisis of the American Family"), and Dr. Laura Landen ("Expelled—With Good Reason"). Dr. Landen spoke for our induction ceremony.

**TX-EPSILON(4405)** [University of St. Thomas; advisor, Steve Jensen] NEW ADVISOR

**TX-ZETA(4406)** [Trinity University; advisor, Blinn Combs] NEW ADVISOR

**TX-IOTA(4409)** [Texas A&M University; advisor, Scott Austin] Though the Texas Iota chapter is small, it is quite active. This year, several chapter members, along with some other students planned an undergraduate journal. The first issue of *Aletheia* is planned for the end of the spring term.

**TX-LAMBDA(4411)** [St. Mary's University; advisor, Glenn Hughes] At our March meeting, we discussed the next event, a showing of the film "City of God." Amanda Guerra, our President, and Kimberly Vela, a new member, plan to lead the post-film

discussion. We also reviewed last month's "Meeting of the Minds" program. Approximately 140 people attended the event where Dr. William Bhurman (Theology) portrayed St. Augustine, Dr. Teresa Van Hoy (History) portrayed Boudicca, Dr. Wayne Owens (Philosophy) portrayed Lau-Tzu, and Dr. Peggie Curet (English) played Shakespeare. The April meeting at Thai Taste (a regular meeting place for our chapter) looked over the PST Newsletter and discussed the activities of other chapters. The showing of "City of God" was cosponsored by the International Relations department; at the conclusion, some of the topics discussed were the use of religion in the film, the cycle of violence and revenge illustrated in the movie, the importance of authority figures, and the nature versus nurture problem. Approximately forty students attended the showing. We are also considering a final chapter banquet for the end of the school year.

**VA-ALPHA(4701)** [Christopher Newport University; advisor, Dawn Hutchinson] The Christopher Newport chapter elected Tyler Wake as President and Christopher Schulz as Vice-President. The chapter also recognized two associate members along with seven new members.

**VA-GAMMA(4703)** [James Madison University; advisor, Anne M. Wiles] Amanda Cassidy, the president of the chapter for two years, was voted the outstanding senior in philosophy by the faculty. Michael Milona was selected the outstanding student in Political Science (Michael's essay on Descartes appeared in the April issue of *Dialogue*—ed.) The secretary of the chapter, Ruth Martini, completed a 140 page thesis under the direction of Dr. Wiles, the chapter advisor.
